






ANGELS AMONG US

Since 2016, MLBA Chapters have participated in our annual **Angel Program**, which challenges each site to partner with other local non-profits to donate gifts during the Holiday season. In 2020—thanks to **100% Chapter participation!**—12,519 gifts were collected.

THE BLUE HEART CONTEST

In 2020, we challenged our sites to encourage team members to sign up for *recurring donations to MLBA* via paycheck deduction—and the results were incredible!

Overall, we saw a **5% increase in donations** across the organization.

DOING EVERYTHING WE CAN, EVERY SINGLE DAY

With all the challenges that 2020 posed, coming together to give back mattered more than ever. We distributed over \$55K in grants to U.S. recipients; more than \$15K in grants to Philippines recipients; and several thousands of dollars in grants to recipients in LATAM via support for COVID relief, Hurricane lota, Hurricane Eta, and Volcano Taal, among others.
